AN ORDINANCE

Approving the Water Department Rules and Regulations
Established by the Director of Water and Declaring an
Emergency.

WHEREAS, The Director of Water, pursuant to authority conferred by
Section 50.40 of the Revised Code of General Ordinances of the City of Dayton, has
established Rules and Regulations, as attached to this ordinance, for the management
and protection of the water and wastewater works; and

WHEREAS, This Commission has reviewed such Rules and Regulations and
deems them to be in the public interest and to the benefit of the Department of Water;
and

WHEREAS, For the immediate preservation of the public peace, property,
health and safety, and to provide for the usual operation of the Department of Water, it
is necessary that this ordinance take effect at the earliest possible date; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTON:

Section 1. That the Rules and Regulations, as attached to this ordinance,
established by the Director of Water are hereby approved.


Section 2. That copies of the approved Rules and Regulations shall be kept on
file in the office of the Director of Water and in the office of the Clerk of the
Commission.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 27597, passed by the Commission on August 26,
1987, is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereof, the Commission
declares this ordinance to be an emergency measure which shall take effect immediately
upon its passage.
